In 2009, Portland Women's Foundation **increased its giving** and granted **\$190,925** to **26** organizations which provide housing and education services to help women become self-sufficient.

- As with many funders, PWF saw a decline in the overall value of its portfolio in 2008/2009. However, due to the severe economic circumstances impacting individuals, service programs and those who fund them, Portland Women's Foundation members reached deeper into the corpus and **increased 2009 giving**.
- PWF maintained its practice of **funding operating expenses** critical to small programs continuing to successfully serve their clients.
- PWF also gave \$8,456 to TACS for **providing valuable technical assistance** support to our grantees.
